ORDINANCE NO. 213

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING ORDINANCE NO. 210 OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF SAID ORDINANCE NO. 210 AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 154 OF SAID CITY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 210 of the City of ^A Andover, Kansas as passed and adopted on the 30th day of April, 1974 is hereby amended and supplemented to provide that any person, group of persons or agents, tenants or any one or more persons occupying lands or representing the owner or occupants of lands upon which, or to which, a sanitary sewer connection has been knowingly made in violation of the terms of this ordinance shall, or the terms of this ordinance otherwise be knowingly made, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and assessed a penalty of not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$100.00 for each violation aforesaid.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. 154 of the City of Andover, Kansas as passed and adopted on the 12th day of June, 1971 is hereby repealed.
