ORDINANCE NO. 214

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND SUSPENDING THE EFFECT OF ORDINANCE NO. 147 OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS, AND ENACTED PURSUANT TO HOUSE BILL NO. 1623, AS PASSED AND ADOPTED BY THE 1974 SESSION OF THE KANSAS LEGISLATURE AND ANNEXING TO THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF SAID CITY A TRACT OF LAND LYING IMMEDIATELY NORTH OF THE SECOND ADDITION TO ANDOVER HEIGHTS, AN ADDITION OF SAID CITY, WHICH LAND IS ANNEXED AT THE REQUEST OF THE OWNERS THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS:

Section 1. That for the purpose of this Ordinance an emergency is hereby declared and the first reading of this Ordinance suspended as might otherwise be required by Ordinance No. 147 of the City of Andover, Kansas enacted on the 10th day of November, 1970.

Section 2. That there is hereby annexed to the City of Andover, Kansas the following described real property located in Butler County, Kansas, to-wit:

Beginning at an exact point at the Northeast corner of Lot 7, Block 1, 2nd Addition to Andover Heights, thence due North 185', thence due West 120', thence due North 10', thence due West 60', thence due South 65', thence due West 125', thence Southeasterly to a point 110' West of the Northeast corner of Lot 2, Block 3, 2nd Addition to Andover Heights, thence due East 170', thence due North to the Northwest corner of Lot 7, Block 1, 2nd Addition to Andover Heights, thence due East 120', back to the point of beginning. Located in the Northeast Quarter of Section 7, Township 27, Range 3 East, Butler County, Kansas.

Section 3. That the above annexed land is annexed to the corporate limits of the City of Andover, Kansas, pursuant to House Bill 1623, as passed and adopted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas, and is so annexed upon the request of the owners thereof.

The above Ordinance duly passed and adopted this 28<sup>th</sup> day of May, 1974.
