ORDINANCE NO. 216

AN ORDINANCE ENACTED PURSUANT TO AUTHORITY OF K.S.A. 1973 SUPP. 12-3009 AND K.S.A. 12-3010 AND ADOPTING BY REFERENCE, THE MODEL CODE OR ORDINANCE KNOWN AS "STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE FOR KANSAS CITIES, 1974 EDITION", AND PROVIDING FOR CERTAIN EXCEPTIONS THERETO AND PROVIDING FOR THE MARKING AND SUPPLYING OF OFFICIAL COPIES AS PRESCRIBED BY STATUTE AND PROVIDING A GENERAL PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF, AND REPEALING ORDINANCES NO. 6 AND 173

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS:

SECTION 1: That pursuant to K.S.A. 1973 Supp. 12-3009 and K.S.A. 12-3010 there is hereby adopted by reference the so-called "Standard Traffic Ordinance For Kansas Cities" 1974 Edition, as published and prepared by The League of Kansas Municipalities, the same as if said model or standard code were set out in full therein, except for those portions thereof hereinafter omitted or deleted.

SECTION 2: That Section 33 shall be deleted from said Standard Model Code or Ordinance and previous existing speed limits as adopted by ordinance enacted prior hereto shall still be deemed to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: That the City Clerk of Andover, Kansas shall prepare and mark three copies of said Standard Code or Ordinance, by marking or stamping thereon, "Official Copy as Incorporated by Ordinance No. 216", with all sections or portions thereof intended to be omitted clearly marked to show any such omission or showing the sections, articles, chapters, parts or portions that are incorporated, as the case may be, and to which shall be attached a copy of this Ordinance, and filed with the City Clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable business hours.

SECTION 4: For all offenses under said Standard or Model Code where no specific fine or imprisonment is provided, the fine shall be not less than \$5.00 or more than \$100.00 and no imprisonment for more than 30 days or both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 5: That Ordinances numbered 6 and 173 of the City of Andover are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and publication.
