

RESOLUTION 25-29

A RESOLUTION ADJUSTING THE SEWER CONNECTION SURCHARGES FOR THE ANDOVER WASTEWATER UTILITY

WHEREAS, the City of Andover, Kansas (the “City”) operates a wastewater collection and treatment system (“Wastewater Utility”); and

WHEREAS, the costs of operating and maintaining this system continue to increase; and

WHEREAS, Chapter XVI, Article 8, Subsection 16-702 of the Code of the City of Andover, Kansas (the “Code”) provides for the adjustment of base rate sewer connection surcharge fee by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City finds it necessary to adopt this Resolution to adjust the sewer connection surcharges for the Wastewater Utility.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. *Sewer Connection Surcharge, Assessment.* Pursuant to Chapter XVI, Article 8, Subsection 16-702 of the Code, the sewer connection surcharge as assessed in Section 16-702 (a) and (b) of the Code is set to remain at \$3,463.35 for users inside the City and \$4,329.19 for users outside the corporate limit of the City as of January 1, 2025, and shall increase annually by 2.5% beginning January 1, 2026.

SECTION 2. *Sewer Connection Surcharge, Minimum Fee.* The Sewer Connection Surcharge Minimum Fee assessed in Section 16-704 of the Code of the City of Andover is set to remain at \$3,463.35 for users inside the City and \$4,329.19 for users outside the corporate limit of the City as of January 1, 2025, and shall increase annually by 2.5% beginning January 1, 2026.

SECTION 3. *Effective Date.* This Resolution shall supersede any prior resolution establishing the same fees or charges, but shall not amend any fee or service charge not amended in this Resolution, and shall take effect and be in force after its adoption by the Governing Body and publication as required by law.
