ORDINANCE NO. 235

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NUMBER 231 OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS ON THE GROUNDS AND FOR THE REASON THAT THE COMPUTATIONS OF ASSESSMENTS THEREIN CONTAINED ARE ERRONEOUS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS

1. That Ordinance Number 231 as enacted by the governing body of the City of Andover, Kansas on June 10, 1975 which Ordinance related to the levying of assessments for sanitary sewer improvements against all of Lot 1, Lot 2, Lot 3, Lot 4, East 50 feet of Lot 5, West 100 feet of Lot 5, Lot 6, and Reserve "A", all in Koob Tracts in said City, should be and the same is hereby repealed ~~on the grounds~~ and for the reason that the assessments therein levied were incorrectly calculated and erroneous.

2. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and publication once in the official City newspaper.
