On behalf of **Andover Senior Center**, we would like to introduce ourselves. We are a non-profit 501c3 organization, tasked with providing residents over fifty a place to gather in Andover, Kansas. We are governed by a volunteer board of directors. We encourage all to attend and socialize, meet with friends, attend our many activities, and have a friendly atmosphere to enrich their lives.

Our membership has grown to over 500 members, in or near Andover. Since we must actively seek financial help, we are reaching out to local businesses and individuals that have an interest in Andover and would benefit from the publicity our center can provide as well as being 100% tax deductible

. We provide a lunch Monday through Friday for our community with only a \$5.00 suggested donation. We provide many more services, such as arts and crafts, Bible study, a monthly book club, a quilters group, balance and exercise classes and several weekly card games. just to name a few. We have also begun a partnership with our local school district. Students are bringing special activities to the senior center to create wonderful social connections between the two age groups.

Our support comes partially from the Department of Aging of Butler Country with a grant each year, but it covers less than 40% of our entire budget. Our Senior Center is not a part of the City of Andover, but we do receive \$5,500 a year from the city. We must hold fundraiser lunches every month and other special fundraisers throughout the year, such as the annual craft show in November. We also participate with Greater Andover Days. We rely on individuals and companies for their generous donations, no matter how small. For instance, we have great turnouts for the Chief of Police and Mayor each month with doughnuts provided by a local shop.

Other great local sponsors include banks, senior living facilities, local businesses, hospice agencies, counseling centers, healthcare providers and funeral homes. One way these businesses help, is by providing funds to purchase food for our fundraisers each month, or catering Thanksgiving and Christmas dinner, providing monthly birthday cakes or even donuts and snacks. Merchandise gift cards for our weekly Bingo are very popular. Any monetary commitment is very much appreciated. We encourage these sponsors to schedule informational talks for our members about their services.

Looking for a few members to make our desserts for daily lunches. We would provide all the supplies needed.


