Sale & Discharge of Fireworks

The sale and discharge of fireworks within the City of Andover, Kansas shall be permitted at the following dates and times:

Friday, June 27 - Saturday, June 28

Sale: 8 a.m. - 11:59 p.m.

Discharge: 10 a.m. - 11:59 p.m.

Sunday, June 29 - Wednesday, July 2

Sale: 8 a.m. - 10 p.m.

Discharge: 10 a.m. - 10 p.m.

Thursday, July 3 - Saturday, July 5

Sale: 8 a.m. - 11:59 p.m.

Discharge: 10 a.m. - 11:59 p.m.

Even with 2025 legislative changes, the City of Andover retains full authority to determine how and when fireworks are sold and used within city limits.

REMINDER:

Since 2023, fireworks at 13th Street Sports Park have been prohibited.

With native grasses in the park, there is too much fire danger.

RATE CHANGES FOR 2025

Wastewater usage rates (sewer) go into effect July 1, 2025

The City must increase monthly sewer rates to fund essential upgrades to our aging wastewater treatment plant that started construction on May 19, 2025. While our sewer collection system is in excellent shape, the treatment plant faces critical challenges, including outdated equipment from 1977, capacity issues, and new state-mandated phosphorus limits that our current system cannot meet. The \$47 million expansion will ensure long-term reliability, regulatory compliance, and service quality.

Waste Connections new rates go into effect starting August 1, 2025.

This is a 3% increase from last year.

WATER FUND: Water surcharge rates go into effect July 1, 2025

While the City of Andover does not operate water distribution, the City does own the water lines providing service. This places responsibility on the City to replace failed water lines and relocate water mains.

The minimum user surcharge billed by Wichita and remitted to the City of Andover will increase \$1.00 per month, raising it from \$1.35 to \$2.35 starting July 1, 2025.

The minimum surcharge will increase annually beginning January 1, 2026 - January 1, 2028 at \$0.35 per month for each user
