

Change to Animal Ordinance – Where to Pick Up Lost Dogs



The Andover Police Department makes every effort to return all found dogs to their owners.

First, all dogs picked up in the City of Andover are checked for a tag or owner-identifying microchip.

If the dog's owner cannot be determined, effective 1/1/13, all found dogs will be taken to Wichita Animal Services Shelter, 3303 North Hillside Street Wichita, KS 67219.

Change to Animal Ordinance - Fees



There is a \$45 fee for any dog picked up and impounded at the Wichita Animal Services Shelter.

Each day (3 maximum) the dog is not picked up, an additional \$10 fee is assessed.

If a dog is not up-to-date on rabies vaccination, an additional \$10 fee is assessed.

Change to Animal Ordinance – Fees Continued



Owners of dogs found running at large may be subject to additional fees:

Running at Large: \$50

• *No License: \$25*

Rabies Vaccinations Not Up-to-Date: \$25

Change to Animal Ordinance – Disposal of Unclaimed Dogs

Dogs not picked up from the Wichita Animal Services Shelter after the three-day holding period will either be adopted out through the Kansas Humane Society or euthanized. This decision is based on whether or not the dog is determined adoptable by the staff at the Humane Society and Wichita Animal Services Shelter.
